MINUTES

MATTERS ARISING

389/2014 Royston Hall Management Committee – Cllr Wormleighton expressed concern about the hiring fees of the hall and will write to the Management Committee separately regarding this. Cllr H. Lewis will also bring this up at their next meeting.
