MATTERS ARISING

671/2026 ROSPA Playground Inspection Report:

- One quote has been received and the other is awaited for resurfacing and repairs to the fence.
- The Clerk reported that the figure of spares for play equipment had not included installation and the new price is £739.29. This was agreed.

673/2026 Speed Limit, Llyswen – The Clerk reported that she has not yet had a reply.

674/2026 Letter from Bronllys Residents – A further unsigned letter was received from the Residents of Bronllys: “Whilst an attempt has been made by Butler Wall Homes to improve the grass verge by rolling it, a lot of village people think it is unacceptable. The man hole is proud, it needs top soil spread on the verge to level the ground and finishing. Surely it’s not hard to get this achieved.

The hedge and grass verge from Beacons View to Watson Cottages is overgrown making it difficult for elderly people to walk along the path.

We the residents of Bronllys hope this can be achieved. It would be nice to having it look like it was before the work was carried out”.

It was agreed that:

- a. The Clerk will contact Butler Wall Homes regarding the grass verge.
- b. The Clerk will contact Powys County Council regarding the grass verge from Beacons View to Watson Cottages as this falls under their remit.
- c. The Clerk will contact the Estates Department of Powys Local Health Board regarding the hedge from Beacons View to Watson Cottages as this is their responsibility.
