The meeting commenced with the election of Chairperson. Cllr Mr. M. Bouette was proposed for Chairperson by Cllr Doughty and seconded by Cllr Evans.

There were no declarations of interest expressed.

**MINUTES**

The minutes of the meeting held on the 10<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 were read, agreed and confirmed as a correct record. This was proposed by Cllr Hughes and seconded by Cllr Evans.

**MATTERS ARISING**

632/2024 Pontywal Play Area – Cllr Williams reported that Stephan Butcher, Countryside and Outdoor Recreation Officer had provided and installed rubber mats in the play area free of charge.

556/2020 Field Opposite Bronllys Garage – The Clerk reported that she had received an E Mail from Adam Nickson, Planning Enforcement Officer – “The site now has an agent appointed and has started the process for application for change of use of the land”.

631/2024 – Funding For Llyswen – Cllr Hughes on behalf of the Llyswen Hall Committee thanked Bronllys Community Council for both the £1,000 and £500 recently donated.

632/2024 – Llyswen Show – The Clerk reported that she had contacted to inform the Show Committee that Bronllys Community Council would be happy to sponsor the children’s craft section.

633/2024 Welsh Water, Llyswen – Cllr Doughty reported that it is expected that the work will take more than the planned 28 weeks but that there are some embargo dates when work will cease, e.g. Royal Welsh Show.

634/2024 MANGAR Community Cushions – The Clerk reported that she had obtained costings as agreed at the last meeting. The cost is £3,500 excluding VAT for each cushion. It was agreed that the Community Council would not proceed any further with this.

### **CORRESPONDENCE**

The Clerk reported that she had received communication from Zurich regarding the insurance for the forthcoming year, total cost = £1,355.42.

A letter was received from Powys County Council regarding Bronllys Tree Preservation Order 131 which is regarding the tree on the land 100 metres North West of Greenfields, Drovers Meadow, Bronllys.
