- 37 wanted renewable energy/solar park
- 44 wanted care for veterans
- 42 wanted workshops health related
- 46 wanted open areas
- 49 wanted a market garden

Bus routes through from East to West Lodge

Mansion House used as Welsh Headley Court or half way house for veterans

Develop and must be sustainable. No carbon footprint (not as currently built by local builders)

Local use and employment

Nursing home
