MATTERS ARISING

364/2013 State of Bollards and Cycle Route, Bronllys – Cllr Williams reported that this work has been carried out.

375/2014 Speeding of Vehicles, Llys Meillion – Cllr Lloyd reported that a meeting had taken place on the 14th January, 2015 with PCO Jason Hawkins. PCO Hawkins informed the meeting how they could access funding and how to set up a speeding community. There has been a greater police/speeding van presence in the village also recently. Cllr Lloyd will keep the Community Council informed as to further progress with this.
