DECLARATION OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest expressed.

MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting held on the 14th January, 2026 were read, agreed and confirmed as a correct record. This was proposed by Cllr Bouette and seconded by Cllr Hughes.

MATTERS ARISING

660/2025 – Planning Update – Cllr Bouette reported that no communication from PEDW has been received regarding the outcome.

669/2025 Gwnfas View, Bronllys The Clerk reported that an Enforcement Notice was issued on the 21st January, 2026. The landowner now has 28 days to lodge an appeal with Planning and Environment Decisions Wales (PEDW). If no appeal is made then, due to the site being used for residential purposes, the landowner will have 12 months to cease the residential use and remove the caravan from the land in accordance with the requirements of the notice.

670/2026 Bus Shelter, Bronllys – Cllr Williams reported that the bus shelter has now been painted.

671/2026 ROSPA Playground Inspection Report –The Councillors confirmed they had reviewed the report in full, and after discussion, the following initial plan was agreed:

- Cllr Williams will contact Steve Forkings to request that the ivy and leaves on the playground fence be cleared.
- It was agreed that two quotes will be obtained for resurfacing and for repairs to the fence; Cllr Lewis and Cllr Davies will undertake this.

- Cllr Lewis will take some photographs and forward them to the Clerk to send to Steve Butcher for any assistance with broken parts etc.
- Cllr Williams will contact Steve Powell from the Anchorage Caravan Park to check on ownership of the fence.

672/2026 Pothole, Neuadd Terrace – This has now been completed.

673/2026 Bollard on Island, Bronllys – This has now been completed.

- Planning Application 25/1901/LBS – Chapel at Bronllys Hospital, Bronllys – Internal and External Works, including partial demolition, refurbishment to the roof, windows and doors. There were no objections expressed.
- Planning Application 26/0027/FUL – Erection of 2 dwellings within the residential curtilage of Rock House, including improvements to access – Rock House, Llyswen, LD3 OVR. There were no objections expressed, however Cllr Hughes wanted it noted that it should remain as two single dwellings.
