**DECLARATION OF INTEREST**

**MINUTES**

The minutes of the meeting held on the 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 were read, agreed and confirmed as a correct record. This was proposed by Cllr Lewis and seconded by Cllr Hughes. The minutes of the extraordinary meeting held on the 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 were read, confirmed as a correct record. This was proposed by Cllr Evans and seconded by Cllr Davies.

**MATTERS ARISING**

556/2020 Field Opposite Bronllys Garage – The Clerk reported that she had once again E Mailed Gemma Bufton, Planning Officer for an update but had received no reply. Following discussion it was agreed that a formal request be made to Powys County Council under Freedom of Information.

580/2021 Rights of Way, Shrubbery Lane, Llyswen – This remains ongoing.

604/2022 Charging Points for Electric Vehicles – Cllr Evans reported that Powys County Council no longer have any resources for the provision of charging points but that he will continue to look into this.

619/2023 Repair of Equipment, Play Area, Pontywal Lane – The Clerk reported that the equipment has arrived from Kompan and work should be completed in the near future. Cllr Williams reported that the tree has also been moved in the play area.

620/2023 Road Surface Derw – This work has now been completed.

623/2023 Trees on Haemorrhage Hill – This remains ongoing.

625/2023 Neuadd Terrace Play Area Equipment – The Clerk reported that two quotes had been received from Stephen Butcher for a Basket/Nest Swing – Adplay £3,850.00 and Dragon £2,870.00. The Dragon cost is cheaper because Stephen Butcher will supply and fit the grass safety matting required. It was agreed that the Community Council would purchase from Dragon.

626/2023 Cutting of Trees in Moat – Cllr Williams reported that this work has now been completed, however, 2 trees were found to be unsafe and need dismantling due to unsafe root plates. Following discussion it was agreed that Climbing Hands Arb Ltd. be asked to undertake this work in the near future.

627/2023 Bronllys Churchyard Wildlife Area – The Clerk reported that complaints had been received regarding the positioning of the wildlife area in the churchyard. Currently the back of the churchyard has been left for wildlife but this is where the bronze crosses mark the graves of patients who died from Bronllys Hospital. It was therefore agreed that the area left for wildlife would be moved to the front of the churchyard by the wall which does not impede any graves. The Clerk will inform the grass cutting contractor.
