DECLARATION OF INTEREST

Cllr Laurie-Parry declared an interest in the Planning Applications and the letter from Llyswen and Boughrood Show.

MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting held on the 12th February, 2018 were read, agreed and confirmed as a correct record. This was proposed by Cllr Williams and seconded by Cllr Lloyd.

MATTERS ARISING

453/2017 Primary School Llyswen and Talgarth – Cllr Laurie-Parry reported that Powys are putting on free transport for pupils so they feel there is no need for a crossing. Also, someone is being employed until Easter to see pupils and parents across the road. It was pointed out that there is a crossing in place by the school for the children from Talgarth. It was agreed that the Clerk write to Kirsty Williams to ask if a crossing could be put in place for the children of Bronllys.

472/2017 Powys War Memorial Project – Cllr Laurie-Parry reported that she has spoken to Land Registry and is awaiting a response. The Clerk has asked Josh Davies to resubmit his original quote for the War Memorial in Bronllys and will ask him for a quote to repaint and re-letter the War Memorial in Llyswen, and also to put some hooks onto the bottom to hang wreaths off.

473/2017 Speed Indicator Devices, Llyswen – The markings and signage on the 3 entrances to the village are still not in situ. Cllr Laurie-Parry agreed to chase this with the Trunk Road Agency.

475/2017 Visit to the Palace of Westminster – Cllr Laurie-Parry reported that she had spoken to Paul Herdman but he does not have a coach suitable. It was agreed that the Clerk contact Williams Coaches for a quote.

477/2017 Rubbish Bin, Llyswen – Cllr Laurie-Parry reported that she has asked the Road Trunk Agency to relocate the rubbish bin.

481/2017 Overgrown Trees, Main Highway, Llyswen – Cllr Laurie-Parry reported that she has asked the Road Trunk Agency to undertake the cutting of these trees.

482/2017 Road Surface, Mintfield Lane – The Clerk reported that she has had no response from Ian Mills or Liam Fitzpatrick of Powys County Council regarding this. It was agreed that the Clerk directly to PAR Homes regarding this.

483/2017 Neighbourhood Watch – Cllr Lewis reported that he is receiving the information from Cllr Williams which in turn has been put on the Community Council Face Book page.

484/2017 Light LS51, Llyswen – Cllr Hughes reported that this light is still not switched on. The Clerk will chase with Colin Davies again.

486/2018 Play Area Pontywal Lane – The Clerk is yet to receive a quote from Kompan but will chase this. It was reported that the trees have now been cut and are no longer hanging over the play area.

487/2018 Crazy Paving at End of Neuadd Terrace – Cllr Williams reported that Carl Selby will provide a quote for this. Cllr Laurie-Parry has the details of the Probation Service if we wish to go down that avenue.

489/2018 Village Sign Outside Royston Hall – Cllr Lewis had got a quote for £830.00 plus VAT plus £45 delivery. Councillors felt that this was a lot of money and it was suggested that Cllr Lewis contact Josephine Rumsey the Clerk to Talgarth Town Council to see where they got their noticeboard from and obtain a quote.

490/2018 Benches by War Memorial, Llyswen – Cllr Williams reported that Carl Selby will repair the two benches when the weather improves.

490/2018 State of Road Surface in Bronllys – The Clerk reported that she has contacted Colin Davies and he has put in for resurfacing but will arrange for the potholes to be plugged in the meantime.

491/2018 Moat, Bronllys – Cllr Williams reported that Carl Selby is going to repair the wooden boards and the post and wire fence around the moat area.

492/2018 Steps Leading Down to River, Llyswen – The Clerk reported that the present lease of land was for 20 years and expired on the 1st March, 2018. The trustees of the Swansea and Brecon Diocesan Trust are prepared to extend the lease for a further 20 years on terms to be discussed and agreed.

With regard to the steps within the lease, item 2 iv, refers to the maintenance of the steps as being the tenants responsibility. It was agreed that the Clerk contact the Trustees of the Trust to ask for their terms of a new lease, a copy of the old lease and who is responsible for the insurance for the steps.

CORRESPONDENCE

A letter was received from Llyswen and Boughrood Show asking for a donation towards the running of the Show. Following discussion it was agreed that the Community Council sponsor the Children's Craft and Photography section at a total cost of £100.00. This was proposed by Cllr Wormleighton and seconded by Cllr Hughes.

Planning Application P/2018/0162 – Erection of Extensions, conversion of garage and erection of a detached garage at Trevomen, 1 Riverside, Llyswen – There were no objections voiced.

Planning Application P/2018/0192 – Full: Installation of 2 no. rapid electric vehicle charging stations along with associated equipment at Bronllys Service Station, Bronllys – There were no objections voiced.

Planning Application P/2018/0217 – Application for consent to display an advertisement at land adjacent Upper Barn, Llandefalle – There were no objections voiced.

A grant application form was received from the Royston Hall Management Committee for the purchase of a cupboard at a cost of £795.58. Following discussion it was proposed by Cllr Williams and seconded by Cllr Mrs. S. Lewis that we give £250.00 towards the total cost. This was agreed by all.

Membership of One Voice Wales for 2018/19 was received at a cost of £135.00. It was proposed by Cllr Mrs. S. Lewis and seconded by Cllr Ms. A. Lloyd that we go ahead with membership for the forthcoming year.
