DECLARATION OF INTEREST

Cllr Powell, Cllr H. Lewis and Cllr S. Lewis declared an interest in Llyswen Cheeky Monkeys Out of School Club.

The minutes of the meeting held on the 4th May, 2016 were read, agreed and confirmed as a correct record.

MATTERS ARISING

<u>375/2014 Speeding of Vehicles, Llys Meillion</u> – The Clerk reported that she had had a reply to her E Mail from the Welsh Government regarding Speed Indicator Devices to the effect that officials are currently finalising guidance on the use of speed indicator devices and that Llyswen will be considered in line with that guidance when completed. Speed Indicator Devices must only be provided by the Welsh Government to ensure they meet the necessary requirements for highway equipment.

Cllr Richards reported that she had recently driven through some villages with posters on lampposts saying "20mph is plenty". It was agreed that Llyswen Primary School be approached to ask if the pupils would be interested in designing posters that could be put on lampposts through Llyswen. It was agreed that a prize would be given for two categories, i.e. infants and juniors. It was agreed that the Clerk write to the school regarding this.

389/2014 Royston Hall Management Committee – There was nothing further to report on this.

<u>393/2014 Powys Wellbeing Group</u> – It was reported that questionnaires have been distributed throughout Bronllys and Llyswen. A public meeting will be held in the Royston Hall, Bronllys on Tuesday 14th June, 2016 at 7.00 p.m.

<u>410/2015 Grants for War Memorials</u> – Cllr Powell reported that the application has been completed and quotes are awaited from local stonemasons.

<u>415/2015 Public Meeting Re. Proposed Closure of Gwernyfed High School</u> – There was nothing further to report on this.

<u>426/2016 Post Office</u>, Bronllys – The Clerk reported that she had received a reply to her E Mail from the Post Office. Following a visit to the branch, the Branch Manager has been advised to remove any obstructions from in front of the access doors and also to ensure that the bin is not obstructing the walkway into the branch.

With regards to lack of automatic doors at the branch, we are advised that the doors are within the guidelines of the Equality Act and as such, the branch are not required to install automatic doors.

The Clerk reported that she had contacted the Post Office again as there are still items obstructing the right hand side of the doorway making it extremely difficult for wheelchair users, people with prams/pushchairs to access the branch. A reply is awaited regarding this.

It was suggested that a buzzer system should be installed as in many banks/post offices and if this does not come to fruition that Brecon Access Group be approached for their opinion.

<u>427/2016 Dog Fouling, Llyswen</u> – Cllr Davies reported that the dog fouling signs in Llyswen need to be erected by the Trunk Road Agency and that they have been informed of this. With regards to signs for the new estate these are in Boughrood depot and Julie Lloyd will arrange for these to be erected. A bin is also available and it was agreed that this would be best placed on the triangle. Cllr Davies will contact Julie Lloyd regarding this.

<u>428/2016 "SLOW" road markings, Bronllys and Llyswen</u> – Cllr Davies reported that orders have gone in to carry out this work.

<u>437/2016 Bus Shelter, Llyswen</u> – The Clerk reported that she had had a response to her E Mail to the effect that the project team are currently in the process of going out to tender on various bits of the project (such as purchase of bus shelters, kerbs etc.) and this will then inform the bigger project plan. As part of the project, it is anticipated that the project manager will write to all community councils along the route to advise of the anticipated location and installation date. The Clerk will contact John Forsey prior to the next meeting for an update regarding this.

<u>438/2016 Bronllys Castle</u> – The Clerk reported that she had received a letter back from CADW to the effect that Bronllys Castle tower was vandalised and required expert repair by CADWs conservation team. The tower was closed for the preparation of the works and following the repairs to replace the dislodged masonry. It was however reopened on the 30th April, 2016.

The Clerk will contact the secretary and ask for a copy of their balance sheet. This will then be discussed further at the next meeting in July.
