DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest expressed.

MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting held on the 8th January, 2025 were read, agreed and confirmed as a correct record. This was proposed by Cllr Hughes and seconded by Cllr Williams.

MATTERS ARISING

644/2020 Bus Shelter, Bronllys – It was reported that once again the bus shelter is in a mess with items other than books being placed in there. Following discussion it was agreed that the bus shelter will be cleared and some books left. Cllr Lewis and Cllr Williams agreed to do this. However, if the facility continues to be abused it will be removed completely. A statement regarding this will also be put on Facebook.

651/2024 Visit to Santa to Bronllys – The Clerk reported that the Fire Service had declined the donation of £100, stating that they do not do it for the money but for the children's enjoyment and also serving as a recruitment drive. They have asked that we put a post on the Community Council's Facebook page regarding the recruitment drive.

The Clerk also reported that she had spoken to Liz Edwards. With regard to informing the Community Council when licences are applied for this is not something that is done anywhere due to the volume of work this would entail. However, she did state that she will ensure that a licence is not provided to both parties for the same day. The Fire Service have already provisionally booked the 23rd December, 2025.

652/2024 Donation from G.D. Harries – The Clerk reported that she had been in contact with Stephan Butcher in regard to what additional piece of equipment would be suitable for the Pontywal play area and he has suggested a “Spinning Pole”. The Clerk has contacted Kompan and the total cost including VAT would be £1,800.96. Following discussion it was agreed that we go ahead with this purchase. **Action By:** Clerk

653/2025 Gate and Sign at Entrance to Moat – Cllr Williams reported that Carl Selby is unable to do this work. Therefore Cllr Williams has asked Mr. Steven Forkings to undertake the repair of the sign and gate.

654/2025 Bronllys Church – Cllr Williams reported that he had attended the meeting on behalf of the Community Council on the 15th January, 2025, the outcome of which was that they are setting up a committee.

A letter was received from Jacqui Wilding, Chair, Bronllys Wellbeing Park CLT Ltd. asking if the Community Council could consider assisting them with a small donation that will aid their organisation’s progression. Cllr Williams proposed a donation of £100 which was seconded by Cllr Doughty and agreed by all present.
