DECLARATION OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest expressed.

MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting held on the 13th March, 2024 were read, agreed and confirmed as a correct record. This was proposed by Cllr Doughty and seconded by Cllr Evans

With regards to the piece of play equipment in the Pontywal Play Area the Clerk reported that Stephan Butcher, Countryside and Outdoor Recreation Officer for Powys County Council had visited the play area and reported that there is no problem with the spinning bowl and that the water can be drained out very easily through the drainage hole.

MATTERS ARISING

556/2020 Field Opposite Bronllys Garage – This remains ongoing.

630/2024 Grass Cutting Contract – The Clerk reported that she had received a quote from Mr. Steven Forkings for £3,250 plus £150 x 2 for the moat. This was agreed by all present.

631/2024 – Funding for Llyswen – Cllr Hughes reported that the Hall Committee have secured a grant for Wi-Fi to be installed but would like help to run it which is £20 per month. Cllr Evans proposed and Cllr Bouette seconded that the Community Council donate £500.00. This was agreed by all present. With regard to the noticeboard Cllr Hughes had received a quote for a plastic, recycled noticeboard at the cost of £1,100. It was proposed by Cllr Lewis and seconded by Cllr Bouette that this be purchased.
