MINUTES

MATTERS ARISING

468/2018 Play Area Pontywal Lane – Cllr Lewis welcomed Mr. Stephan Butcher from Powys County Council to the meeting. Cllr Lewis explained to those present that himself and Mrs. Amanda Page had met with Stephan Butcher in 2019 to discuss the £10,000 that had been allocated to Bronllys. At that time the planning application for the school site was in its infancy and it was agreed that we wait until this had been submitted to discuss this further.

Mr. Butcher explained that the £10,000 was now sitting in his budget and that he would like the money spent this financial year. He explained that he knows the dimensions for the site in Neuadd Terrace and it was agreed that a site meeting be arranged to see what is needed on each play area.

It was agreed that the Clerk arrange a site meeting in the next few weeks.
