367/2013 Parking Llyswen School – The Clerk reported that she had received replies to her letters from Kirsty Williams, AM. She reports that she has not yet received a reply from the Minister with an update on the suggestion of having warning flashing lights on the A470 trunk road. She had

received a response from the Headteacher saying that the school has received quotes to dig and resurface the land at the rear of the school with the intention that the work will be carried out over the summer holidays. Cllr Lloyd reported that the friends of the school have agreed to donate a sum of money for this project and it was proposed by Cllr Hepton that the Community Council donate £200. Cllr Lloyd reported that the length of grass between the garage and monument is overgrown. Cllr Hepton agreed to speak to the new owners of the garage to ask if they would be willing to maintain this piece of land.
