DECLARATION OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest expressed.

MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting held on the 12th November, 2025 were read, agreed and confirmed as a correct record. This was proposed by Cllr Bouette and seconded by Cllr Hughes.

MATTERS ARISING

660/2025 – Planning Update – Cllr Bouette reported that PEDW held a non-statutory hearing at the Royston Hall in November 2025, however no communication has been received to date regarding the outcome.

669/2025 Gwynfas View, Bronllys – The Clerk reported that a letter had been received from the Camping and Caravanning Club stating that they had completed their investigations and have concluded no to proceed with the application. As a result the Clerk had contacted Powys County Council to ascertain when an Enforcement Notice would be served (as per the original planning refusal). A reply was received on the 14th January, 2026 from Powys County Council stating that they are aiming to serve the enforcement notice on the premises within the next 2 weeks.

CORRESPONDENCE

A letter was received from Powys County Council regarding the Precept for 2025/26. A detailed conversation took place and with rising costs and the fact that the Community Council wish to pursue some capital projects in both Bronllys and Llyswen it was proposed by Cllr Bouette and seconded by Cllr Hughes that the precept be increased from £15,000 to £17,000. The Clerk will apply accordingly.

ROSPA Playground Inspection Report – The recent ROSPA report has identified repairs that need to be carried out. It was agreed that the Councillors read the report by the next meeting in order that a plan of works can be drawn up for the next financial year.

Cllr Bouette reported that there is a large pothole outside 21 Neuadd Terrace. The Clerk agreed to log a job with Powys County Council regarding this and also regarding the state of the roads/pot holes in general.
