BASED ON GENUINE GARDEN CITY principles, The Bronllys Well Being Park Community Land Trust (CLT) has been established to enable the development of an inspirational Park for our Mid-Wales communities, with Bronllys Hospital at its heart.

Owned by the local community, it will provide sustainable and affordable housing and transport; work and leisure opportunities; health and well being amenities in support of the existing in-patient palliative care, Mental Health, Day Care Hospital and Pain Clinic services provided by the Bronllys NHS Hospital.

We intend to make it possible for people to live close to their place of work so that local job vacancies can be fulfilled, the community can function effectively, and local young people be

given an opportunity to remain in the area should they wish to do so. Using landscaping to retain its beauty, we will develop discreet homes, and care and sport facilities to meet local needs. This might include a rural day centre, homes offering places to people with dementia, and their partners; a solar recharging hob for community transport, and much more.

The Well Being Park Trust has been established by local residents to own, manage and develop the land surrounding Bronllys Hospital on behalf of local people.

The Trust is now able to open up membership to local residents, thereby giving you ownership, and a say in its future planning, and the management of its activities, ensuring that you will be at the heart of our proposal.
