DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest.

The minutes of the meeting held on the 7th September, 2015 were read, agreed and confirmed as a correct record. Proposed by Cllr Williams and seconded by Cllr Lloyd.

MATTERS ARISING

375/2014 Speeding of Vehicles, Llys Meillion – Cllr Powell reported that she has met with PCSO Jason Hawkins and there is a meeting being held later this week. Cllr Powell also reported that the minister has made a statement to the effect that a 20 mph temporary speed limit on trunk roads will come into force this financial year and this will include Llyswen primary school. She also reported that two lots of speed strips have recently been placed in the village to monitor the speed.

389/2014 Royston Hall Management Committee – Cllr Williams reported that the ante room has been cleared out and work is due to commence this week.

393/2014 Powys Wellbeing Group – Cllr Hughes reported that the Wellbeing Group are still working on a Business Plan, hopefully for presentation to the Powys Health Board Development Committee in November/December 2015. The group have a meeting with Powys Trust Board at the end of October with a view to promoting the Business Plan in preparation to meet with the board members. A revised Newsletter has been recently written and will be put on the Community Council's website.

393/2015 Footpath, Talgarth Road – The Clerk reported that she has written to the Welsh Assembly. They have responded saying that a reply will be sent by the end of October 2015.

397/2015 Defibrillator for Llyswen – Cllr Hughes reported that a training session has been held and the defibrillator is now up and running and been registered with the Ambulance Service. The Clerk reported that she has contacted the company who maintain defibrillators in the area but has yet not received a reply.

400/2015 Dog Waste Bins, Shrubbery Lane – As Councillor Davies was not present there was nothing further to report on this.

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Planning Application P/2015/0772 – Change of use of land to touring caravan park, conversion and extension of existing buildings to provide sanitary, office, retail (site users only) storage and garaging facilities. Creation of new access and installation of private sewage treatment facility at Boxbush Farm, Three Cocks.

There were no objections voiced.

Planning Application P/2015/0837 – Erection of 12 dwellings, 10 car ports and formation of vehicular access road and footpath at land adjacent Bronllys Court, Bronllys.

There were no objections voiced.

Planning Application P/2015/0798 Outline: Erection of a detached dwelling house (all matters reserved) at land part of Wye Garage, Llyswen

Following discussion the Councillors from the Llyswen Ward objected to the above planning application with the following points discussed:

- The existing traffic pattern in Llyswen
- There would be no tanker runaway if something were to go wrong whilst re-fuelling at the garage.
- A fuel tank and interceptor for spillage are under where the proposed dwelling is to be situated.
