**THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING WAS HELD IN LLYSWEN PUBLIC HALL, LLYSWEN ON

The meeting commenced with the election of Chairperson. Cllr Mrs. E. Davies was proposed for Chairperson by Cllr Williams and seconded by Cllr Lewis.

Cllr Lewis was proposed for Vice Chair by Cllr Williams and seconded by Cllr Bouette.

Cllr Lewis will continue as School Governor for Llyswen.

Ms. Zoe Mathias has agreed to undertake the role of Internal Auditor.

DECLARATION OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest expressed.

MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting held on the 8th April, 2026 were read, agreed and confirmed as a correct record. This was proposed by Cllr Lewis and seconded by Cllr Doughty.

MATTERS ARISING

671/2026 ROSPA Playground Inspection Report:

- Cllr Lewis reported that he is awaiting two quotes for resurfacing and repairs to the fence.
- The Clerk reported that the cost of spares for play equipment was £336.69. It was agreed that we would go ahead with this.

673/2026 Speed Limit, Llyswen – The Clerk reported that she had not yet had a reply from the Trunk Road Agency. The Clerk will chase this.

CORRESPONDENCE

The Clerk reported that she had received the insurance documentation for the forthcoming year. The cost of this is £1,462.61. This was agreed.

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An unsigned letter from “Residents of Bronllys” was received. “I would like to bring it to your attention about the number of residents of Bronllys raising their concerns and comments about the grass verges on the Brecon road after the work carried out by Butler Wall Homes. The verges are cut by people from the community to a very high standard, but the reinstatement and finished ground work are finished to a very poor standard. Could you please contact Butler Wall Homes to rectify this to an acceptable standard with top soil, stone raked out etc. They might not live here but we do, it will make the village look a mess”. The Clerk reported that she had contacted Tom Parry from Butler Wall Homes who said that this was on their list of works to complete.

Planning Application P/26/0041/FUL – Internal and External Works, including partial demolition, refurbishment to roof, windows and doors, vehicle parking and upgrade of heating system, Bronllys Hospital, Bronllys. There were no objections expressed.

A letter was received from Llyswen Show committee asking for sponsorship. It was agreed that Bronllys Community Council would sponsor the two children’s classes at a cost of £50 per class.

Cllr Bouette reported that a group has been formed “Friends of Bronllys Green Spaces” who are going to look at funding to enhance Bronllys. A survey will be posted on Facebook and distributed to all dwellings in Bronllys.

Cllr Lewis reported that the pot holes by Tiviety Patch and from Royston Hall to the roundabout are getting worse.

Cllr Hughes reported that the pot holes are also in a bad state of repair at Llyswen School junction. The Clerk will log a job with Powys County Council.

Cllr Bouette reported that the drains on the road from Neuadd Terrace to Bronllys Hospital are blocked and need clearing. The Clerk will log a job with Powys County Council.

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Cllr Doughty reported that on Easter Monday and the Early May Bank Holiday Monday the recycling was not picked up. This led to it being left for another week and when it was picked up the trucks were full and the rubbish fell on the road. The Clerk will contact Powys County Council regarding this.
