DECLARATION OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest expressed.

MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting held on the 8th May, 2024 were read, agreed and confirmed as a correct record. This was proposed by Cllr Williams and seconded by Cllr Evans.

MATTERS ARISING

632/2024 Pontywal Play Area – Cllr Evans reported that the grass in the play area is quite long even after being cut recently. Cllr Williams agreed to speak to Steven Forkings, grass cutter and ask if he could cut the grass lower. This was also the case for the churchyard and the area in Llyswen.

556/2020 Field Opposite Bronllys Garage – The Clerk reported that she had received an update from Adam Nickson, Planning Enforcement Officer – “I have had a chat to the owners of the land’s planning agent late yesterday afternoon, and the planning application for change of use of the land is due to be submitted this week, this will then be passed to planner for review. Once I know the planning reference number I will send this over to you. Plans will be uploaded to the Powys website. Once this has been done, I will update you”.

633/2024 Welsh Water, Llyswen – Cllr Doughty reported that work is progressing well but road closures by the Griffin and past the garage will probably need to happen at some stage.

635/2024 Light in Llyswen – Cllr Hughes reported that the light is still on 24 hours a day. The Clerk will chase Powys County Council regarding this.

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ANY OTHER BUSINESS

636/2024 Accounts 2023/24 – The Clerk tabled the accounts for 2023/24 which have been duly prepared and internally audited. Cllr Bouette signed off the accounts which will be going to full audit this year.

Cllr Williams reported that he had received a telephone call from Mr. Ian Bowen asking if the yellow lines could be removed from the front of the Cock Hotel. It was felt that this was because no review had taken place since the bypass was installed. Cllr Lewis raised that when vehicles are parked in front of the Cock Hotel it is very dangerous when exiting the junction due to not being able to see oncoming traffic. It was also raised that 2 signs have recently been erected on the Cock Hotel stating parking for patrons only. It was agreed that the Clerk raise both issues with Highways.

Cllr Hughes reported that the area surrounding the War Memorial in Llyswen is overgrown and needs cutting back. As the overgrown trees are situated above arms length It was agreed that Cllr Hughes approach a local groundsman to carry out this work.

It was reported that Powys County Council have appointed a contractor to undertake the demolition works of the former school building in Bronllys. However, there is a delay due to nesting birds. An ecologist is monitoring the situation and once the birds have fledged the contractor will be on site to mobilise and start work.

Cllr Bouette reported that once again the bus shelter by Neuadd Terrace is being used for items other than books. It was again reiterated that items other than books will be removed.

Cllr Bouette reported that the goal post in the field behind Neuadd Terrace is broken. It was agreed that the Clerk contact Stephan Butcher to see if Powys will repair or provide a new one.

Cllr Bouette reported that some of the matting had been broken in the Neuadd Terrace play area when the grass was being cut. The Clerk will contact Stephan Butcher regarding this.

The Clerk reported that an anonymous letter had been left at the Royston Hall for the Community Council stating that some meeting minutes were missing from the website. Cllr Lewis agreed to look into this.
